Welcome to the June edition of our newsletter! As the days grow warmer and longer, we are excited to share updates, articles and upcoming events with you.

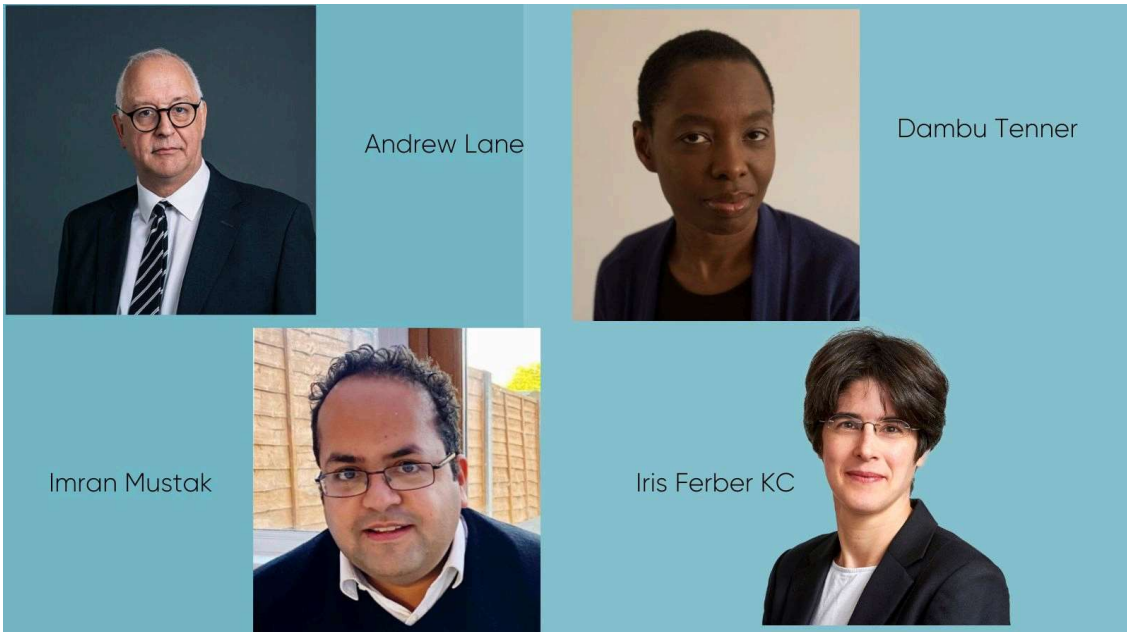
### **Committee Corner: Farewell and Welcome to our New Committee members**
